We will be asking all member families to fill out **emergency forms next year at the pool**. If we were to have (heaven forbid) any type of accident, this will assist medical personnel to know your wishes for your family.

All Kinds of Parties Going On at the Pool



With our full membership, unannounced larger groups and big parties have become an issue at the pool.

Sometimes staff has to scramble to get another life-guard called in to work and other times we'll have extra guards working for a party reservation and a large group ends up being much smaller or canceling at the last minute.

For the safety of all, for fiscal reasons and in order

to allow sufficient time for staffing, we will be implementing some new guest rules for next year.

New Guest Policy for 2010 -
1. Groups of 10 or more must notify the office one week in advance and pre-pay to have sufficient guest passes on account. A \$50 staffing fee will be charged (10 guest passes will be deducted from the account) whether all guests show up or not.

2. Parties of 25 or more must rent the pool (at least one week in advance) for a before- or after-hours party (not during normal hours of operation). Guest passes do not apply to pool rental.

Pool rental forms will be available in the pool office and on our website.

The pool management may discretionarily post a "NO VISITOR" (no guests) notice to prevent over-crowding.

bottles, which brings us to item #2...

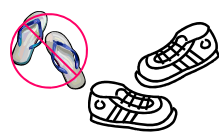
2. No Alcohol.

Swim Lessons

This year LSC offered four two-week sessions of swim lessons. Lesson levels range from Mom & Tot through our most advanced level, Introduction to Swim Team. During all four sessions, our Beginner 1 classes were filled to capacity, with almost all the other classes full, too!

New for 2010 - We will be doing registration a little differently in order to better ensure that your child ends up in the right class level.

Sign-ups will be for one session at a time. Your child's swim teacher will understand your child's particular needs and abilities and will

be able to determine their next appropriate swim class level.

Members will have priority for signing up for the first session, and then members and students currently enrolled in a session will have priority for the subsequent sessions.

We plan to have five swim sessions next year. Tentative dates are:

Session 1, 6/28 – 7/9

Session 2, 7/12 – 7/23

Session 3, 7/26 – 8/6

Session 4, 8/9 – 8/20

Session 5, 8/23 – 9/3
